INTERESTING developments are happening in our region regarding renewable sources of energy (*Independent*, October 17).

Greenearth Energy has been mapping the thermal energy possibilities of our region with extremely good results. In short, 260,000 petajoules of thermal energy are available for energy production from hot rock sources that sit below us.

Australia uses in total, according Greenearth, about five and a half petajoules in total a year, so the amount of thermal energy available is immense.
